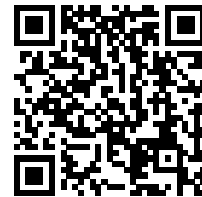
Important Notice: Pesticide, Herbicide and Insecticide Application Notification

Public Act 103-0976 regulates the use of pesticide, herbicide, and insecticide in municipalities. This Act requires municipalities and government entities to give 24 hours of notice before applying pesticide, herbicide, and insecticide on a public right-of-way within the municipality's boundaries. Under Public Act 103-0976, the City of Virden is implementing notification procedures to keep our community informed about pesticide, herbicide, and insecticide applications.

The applications will treat and control insects and broadleaf weeds in the City of Virden areas, mitigating the potential risk of infestation to residents and rights-of-way. Treatment will target the affected areas specifically and may require multiple applications for complete eradication. The application will be conducted by the City of Virden.

Day of Service Notifications

Please note that the Day of Service notification service provided by the City of Virden will continue to be supported. Application Schedule

- **Location:** Within City Limits of Virden Illinois
- **Season:** April 1st – November 30th, 2026
- **Pesticide Time of Application:** Between dawn to dusk
- **Herbicide Time of Application:** Between dawn to dusk
- **Insecticide Time of Application:** Between dawn to dusk
- **Purpose:** Weed control and prevention, invasive species control

Emergency Exceptions

Please note that advance notice requirements may be waived in certain emergency situations, such as a potential disease threat to individuals or natural disaster recovery efforts.

Product List for Weed and Invasive Species Control

1? Bullzeye

- EPA# 42750-61-534
- A broad-spectrum herbicide used for treatment of weeds in municipal infrastructure areas such as sidewalks, curbs, and fence lines.

Active Ingredients:

- Glyphosate, N-(phosphonomethyl)glycine, in the form of its isopropylamine salt. Contains 480 grams per liter or 4 pounds per U.S. gallon of the active ingredient, glyphosate, in the form of its isopropylamine salt. Equivalent to 356 grams per liter or 3 pounds per U.S. gallon of the acid, glyphosate.....41.0%
- OTHER INGREDIENTS.....59.0%
- TOTALS.....100.0%
- Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Apply at a rate of 2/3 oz-13oz in 1 gallon of water per acres

2? Total Solution Triple Threat

- EPA# 10088-81-68562
- Selective use herbicide to control a range of broadleaf weeds.

Active Ingredients:

- Dimethylamine Salt of 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid- 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid 3.8%, 0.33lbs./gallon4.55%
- Dimethylamine Salt of (+)-R-2-(2-Methyl-4-chlorophenoxy) propionic Acid (+)-R-2-(2-Methyl-4-chlorophenoxy) propionic Acid 1.9%, 0.17 lbs/gallon.....2.29%
- Dimethylamine Salt of (+)-R-2-(2,4-Dichlorophenoxy) propionic Acid, (+)-R-2-(2,4-Dichlorophenoxy) propionic Acid 1.9%, 0.17 lbs/gallons.....2.26%
- INERT INGREDIENTS.....90.90%
- TOTALS.....100.0%

- Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Apply at a rate of 1 gallon in 50 gallons of water per acre.
- Entry Restrictions: Do not enter or allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

3? Triplet SF Selective Herbicide

- EPA# 228-312
- Selective use broadleaf weed control for turf grasses, for use on highways, rights-of-way, and other similar non-crop areas.

Active Ingredients:

- Dimethylamine Salt of 2, 4- Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid, 2, 4- Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid 25.38%, 2.38 lb/gal30.56%
- Dimethylamine Salt of (+)-R-2-(2-Methyl-4-chlorophenoxy) Propionic Acid, (+)-R-2-(2-Methyl-4-chlorophenoxy)Propionic Acid 6.75%, 0.63 lb/gal CONTAINS THE SINGLE ISOMER FORM OF MECOPROP-p.....8.17%
- Dimethylamine Salt of Dicamba (3, 6-Dichloro-o-Anisic Acid), 3, 6-Dichloro-o-Anisic Acid 2.30%, 0.22 lb/gal2.77%
- OTHER INGREDIENTS:58.50%
- TOTALS:100.0%
- Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer's label- Apply at a rate of 1.1 – 1.5 oz in 0.5 – 5 gallons of water per 1000 per sq ft
- Entry Restrictions: Do not enter or allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

4? DiBro 2 + 2

- EPA# 228-227
- This Product is a non-selective granular herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. For use in non-cropland.

Active Ingredients:

- Diuron [3-(3,4-Dichlorophenyl) -1, 1-Dimethylurea], Contains 0.8 pound of diuron and 0.8 pound of bromacil per 40 pounds of DiBro 2+2.....2%
- Bromacil (5-Bromo-3-Sec-Butyl-6-Methyluracil), Contains 1.0 pound of diuron and 1.0 of bromacil per 50 pounds of DiBro 2+22%

- OTHER INGREDIENTS:96%
- TOTALS:.....100.0%
- Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer’s label- Apply at a rate of 0.5 to 0.9 pounds of product per 100 sq ft.
- Special label instructions: Do not enter or allow people or pets to enter until dust has settled.

5? Knock-Out II

- This product is a non-selective herbicide for controlling weed and grasses by contact with the root.

Active Ingredients:

- 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid 2-ethylhexylester1.09%
- Bromacil (5-bromo-3-sec-butyl-6-methyluracil)0.98%
- INERT INGREDIENTS:97.93%
- Labeled Application Rate: per manufacturer’s label- Apply at a rate of 0.9 gallons per 1000 sq ft.

These EPA-registered pesticides, herbicides, and insecticides can be safely applied in residential areas. Special instructions and restrictions are listed above.
